## **SECURITY BULLETIN**

The Coordinating Committee for CASC 2010 wishes to advise people who will be participating in this event of the following:

- The safe-keeping of all personal belongings is the sole responsibility of the individual.
- Expensive gizmos, gadgets and large sums of money should be left at home to help avoid the incidence(s) of misplacement/theft.
- A safe-keeping system will be in place at Base Camp to allow for the safe-keeping of valuable items such as passports, airline tickets, etc.
- Little/no jewellery should be worn during CASC 2010.

### **Please Note**

The Guyana Police Force as well as the Guyana Defence Force (GDF) have been informed of the details relating to CASC 2010 and will provide security for and conduct patrols at all locations for the duration of CASC.

Additionally the GDF will be providing uniformed ranks at Base Camp to serve as a deterrent to potential trouble-makers.

We've also developed and will be implementing a simple Security Plan at each site that will be use to conduct CASC activities. This plan includes the issuing of CASC 2010 Identification Card system, check points and holding areas.
