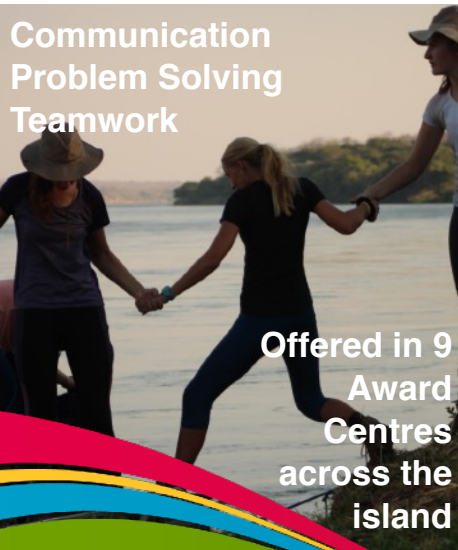

They Completed over 14,000 Voluntary Service Hours!

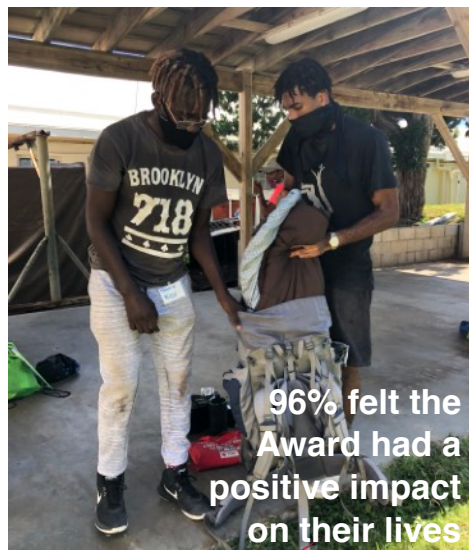


86% of participants continue to volunteer regularly
