


Silver

Silver is the second level of the Award, and takes a minimum of 6 months to complete if you have completed Bronze or 12 months if you have not completed Bronze and you must choose one of the specific sections as a Major. You would be considered a Direct Entrant at this level.

You can start your Silver Award as soon as you've <u>completed</u> your Bronze. If you have not completed Bronze then you must be 15 to start Silver.

There are three specific sections—<u>Voluntary Service</u>, <u>Skill</u> and <u>Physical Recreation</u>—that you'll choose your activities from, plus an <u>Adventurous Journey</u> to complete.

The table below gives you a good idea of what time is involved for each section. If you're already playing a sport, learning a skill (e.g. learning to drive or play a musical instrument), or helping others in your community, once registered, you will be able to use these activities to count towards your required hours:
