



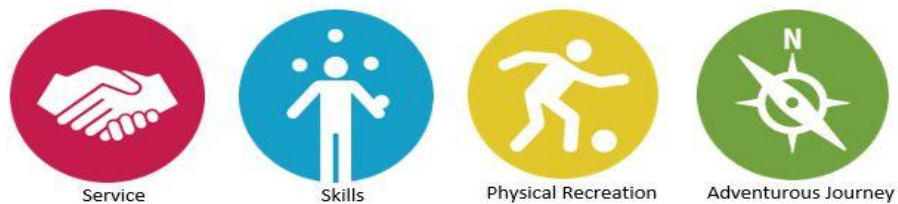
Silver

Silver is the second level of the Award, and takes a minimum of 6 months to complete if you have completed Bronze or 12 months if you have not completed Bronze and you must choose one of the specific sections as a Major. You would be considered a Direct Entrant at this level.

You can start your Silver Award as soon as you've completed your Bronze. If you have not completed Bronze then you must be 15 to start Silver.

There are three specific sections— [Voluntary Service](#), [Skill](#) and [Physical Recreation](#)—that you'll choose your activities from, plus an [Adventurous Journey](#) to complete.

The table below gives you a good idea of what time is involved for each section. If you're already playing a sport, learning a skill (e.g. learning to drive or play a musical instrument), or helping others in your community, once registered, you will be able to use these activities to count towards your required hours:
