

Bronze

Bronze is the first level of the Award, and you can start it in the school year that you turn 14. Bronze takes a minimum of 6 months to complete for 2 of your chosen individual sections. The final individual section will take an additional 3 months totaling 9 months to complete and this is considered a Major.

There are three specific sections—<u>Voluntary Service</u>, <u>Skills</u> and <u>Physical Recreation</u>—that you'll choose your activities from, plus an <u>Adventurous Journey</u> to complete.

The table below gives you a good idea of what time is involved for each section. If you're already playing a sport, learning a skill (e.g. learning to drive or play a musical instrument), or helping others in your community, once registered you will be able to use these activities to count towards your required hours:
